

\*Signed into law in 2018, Oklahoma's Senate Bill 1446 mandates that all physicians complete one hour of CME in pain management per year. To help Oklahoma's physicians better understand how this new law impacts their practice and patients, the Oklahoma State Medical Association is hosting special CMEs in Oklahoma City and Tulsa. This one-hour event offers insight to the legal issues affecting pain management and an overview of the new laws connected with prescribing opioids to patients. All Oklahoma physicians with a DEA license are required to take this one hour course annually.



We are a regional swallowing and voice center.



#### **FEES**

Fiberoptic endoscopic evaluation of swallowing (FEES) exams allow for a thorough assessment of the pharyngeal phase of swallowing and visualization of the pharyngeal and laryngeal anatomy utilizing flexible nasal endoscopy. P.O. trials are administered while the endoscope is in place. The exam allows for detection of aspiration, penetration, backflow, excessive secretion pooling, and anatomical concerns such as protrusions, discolorations, etc. During the exam, the clinician trials strategies and techniques to determine their therapeutic effectiveness.


#### VIDEOSTROBE

A videostroboscopy voice evaluation involves pairing a strobe light with a flexible nasal endoscope or a rigid oral scope to view the vocal fold movement in slow motion. Stroboscopy allows our clinicians to fully assess vocal fold closure and vibration patterns to identify any vocal fold weakness, tension, or vocal pathologies to help determine the best, most individualized plan of treatment.

# PHYSICIAN WELLNESS PROGRAM (PWP)

The Physician Wellness Program (PWP) provides a safe harbor for physicians to address normal life difficulties in a confidential and professional environment. A physician's life can be difficult. Problems with the current health care delivery system, maintaining a healthy work/life/family balance, and dealing with the normal stresses of everyday life do take their toll on physicians.

Often our patients turn to us for counseling and guidance, but who can we turn to when we need to talk through an issue or get some coaching for how to handle the stresses in our lives? Too often the answer is "no one," and that is regrettable because it is important that we be as healthy as possible in our role as health care providers.

It is important that we function at our best in all areas of our life. By addressing areas of difficulty, we can decrease our stress levels and increase our level of resilience and effectiveness.

#### **HOW PWP WORKS**

We have gathered a diverse group of counselors to help our physicians. These counselors provide counseling to active physician members, students, residents, and retired physicians of the Tulsa County Medical Society (TCMS), up to eight visits per calendar year. Non-urgent sessions can be scheduled during regular business hours.

Our counselors maintain a confidential file for each physician. No insurance will be billed and TCMS will not be given any information about those who utilize the program. As such, this program is completely confidential. TCMS will pay a monthly bill based on the number of sessions provided. TCMS membership will be verified.

The Physician Wellness Program (PWP) is available to Tulsa County Medical Society members, including resident and student members. The PWP provides:

- Up to 8 free, confidential sessions with licensed therapist
- Convenient, private location
- No diagnosis specified, no insurance billed, no electronic record kept
- Appointments at convenient hours for physicians

## **IN MEMORIAM**



Robert Melo Melichar, M.D.

TCMS Member Since 1977 (46 Years)

Dr. Robert Melo Melichar ("Dr. Bob") was born on August 8th, 1944 in Caldwell, Kansas to Helen and Melo Melichar. He grew up on a farm with his older sister Melinda and his younger brother Albert in a one-bedroom house with no indoor

plumbing. "Bobby" was a straight A student, an athlete, and was president of his senior class. He was also a prize-winning 4-H'er.

At Kansas State University, Bobby was recruited to join the rowing team, He called rowing "crew", "the hardest thing I ever did, but also the most rewarding." He also joined the ROTC and was very proud to serve his country. He eventually earned the rank of Major in the Army.

While In Medical School at the University of Kansas, fellow medical student Dr. Lucinda (Cindy) Farmer caught his eye. His friends discouraged him from asking her out, saying she was way out of his league. Robert was not easily discouraged, and their courtship evolved into 43 years of marriage and three children, Lori, Jodi and Jerry. Robert credited Cindy with increasing his compassion for those in need, for widening his circle of friends to include community leaders from across the city of Tulsa, and with his love of off-the-beaten-path international travel.

After Medical school Dr. Melichar was accepted into the prestigious Parkland Memorial Hospital surgical residency program under one of his most influential mentors, Dr. Thomas Shires. At Parkland, Dr. Melichar met Dr. John Phillips, who became his close friend and business partner. Dr. Melichar was selected to follow Dr. Shires to the University of Washington in Seattle to complete his residency.

## George S. Mauerman, M.D.

TCMS Member Since 1970 (53 Years)

Dr. George S. Mauerman, devoted father, physician, and friend passed away peacefully in his home early Monday, October 2, at the age of 86.

Born April 6, 1937, in Monroe, WI, George was a Phi Beta Kappa football scholarship graduate of Vanderbilt University. He went on to receive his medical degree from Columbia University. When duty called, he served as a captain at March Air Force Base. Upon completing his orthopedic residency at the prestigious Campbell Clinic in 1970, George joined Eastern Oklahoma Orthopedic Center, now Advanced Orthopedics of Oklahoma. That same year he began serving as the team physician at the University of Tulsa where he worked up until the day he died.

George went on to become one of the most renowned orthopedic surgeons in not only Tulsa, but also the country. His numerous awards and achievements are well documented and established, most notably having the sports medicine facility at The University of Tulsa named after him. Despite his many professional accomplishments, George valued Faith, Family and Friends above all else.

He became a member of Asbury Church in 1970 where he attended the early morning Sunday service followed by Sunday school for over 50 years...
